Road: From Tunbridge Wells get onto the A264 east towards the A21. The entrance is opposite Sandrock Road. Look out for the large stone gates.

Route description

Start: From the Pembury Road (A264) car park by the large information panel at the bottom of the car park.

- A** Follow path down to lakeside boat house
- B** At boat house turn right
- C** Cross the wooden platform and turn left and continue to follow the lakeside path to boat house
- D** Return to car park

Additional information

Free parking.

Opening times: 7:30 till dusk daily.

Other facilities: Public toilets, café and boat hire.

Site/organisation info: Once a private landscaped garden, Dunorlan Park is now an historically important and much loved public park. A Heritage Lottery Fund award of £2.1 million has enabled the restoration of Dunorlan's historic features and improved access into and around the Park.
